## In Memory of Donald Belmore

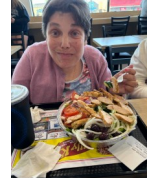

The group picture is at Lamoureux park, from the vendors market and the culture festival.

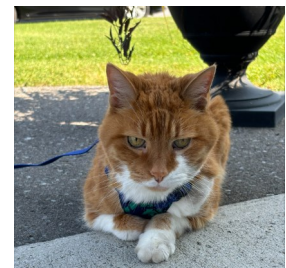

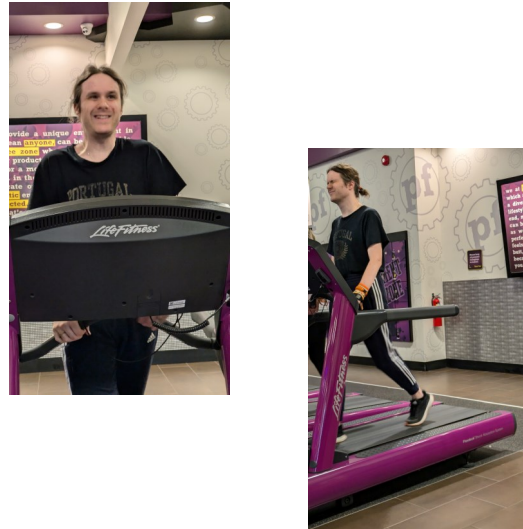

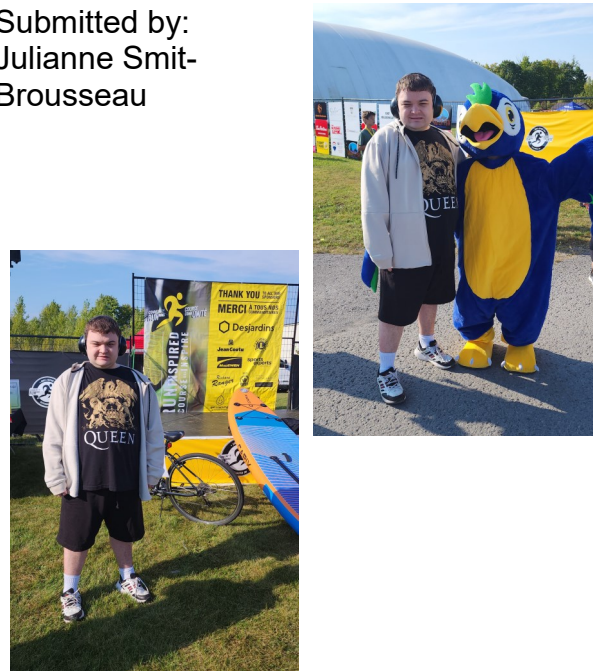

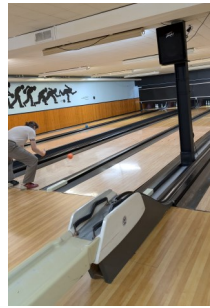
Ashton getting his sweat on!! Ashton spent many days this summer working his muscles at Cornwall's outdoor gym and going for walks by the water.

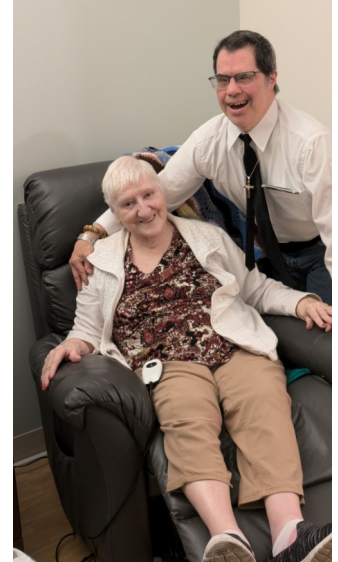

Sam giving out candy to trick-or-treaters. You can see she is loving it! We decorated Halloween cookies afterwards and carved a pumpkin.

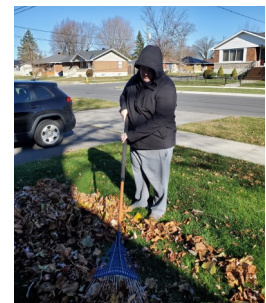

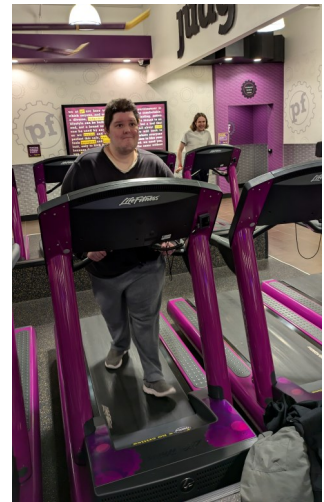
## Success At The Gym

We waited for Kyle, since he usually workouts an hour. While waiting, Sean played a game on his device.

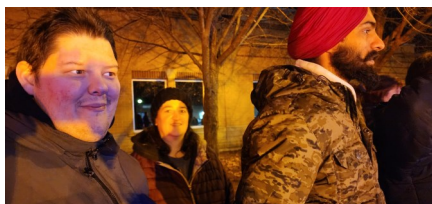

## Happy Retirement Donna!

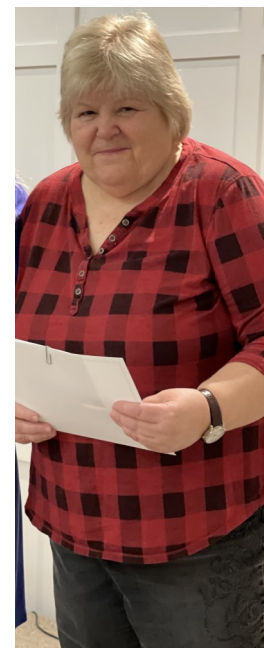
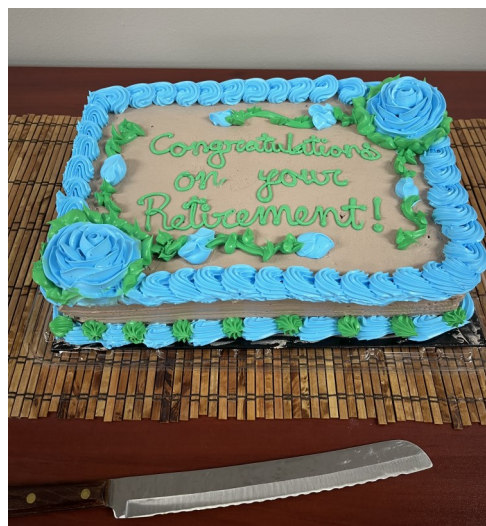
