Isabel and Lucianne went for a haircut, afterward they treated themselves to St-Hubert for lunch!

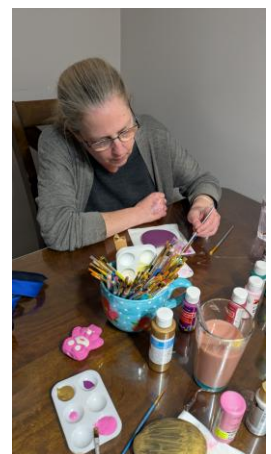
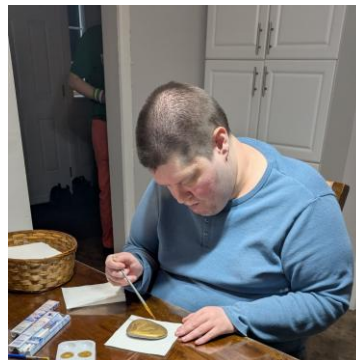

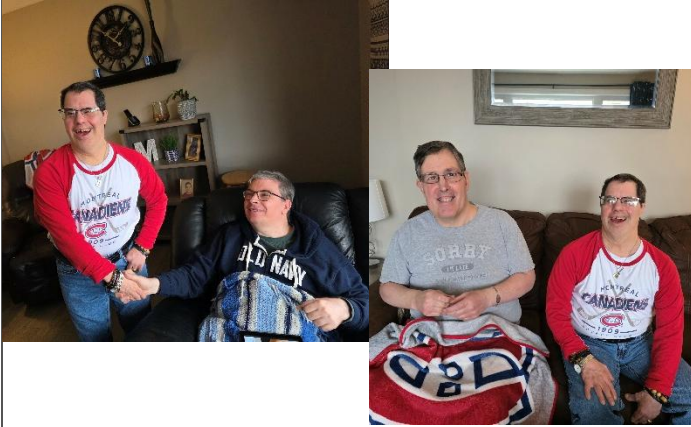

Perry and Terry Take on Toronto and Niagara Falls

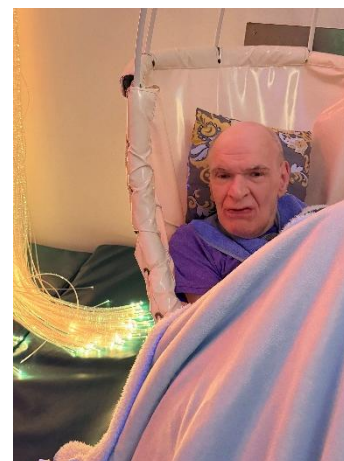
