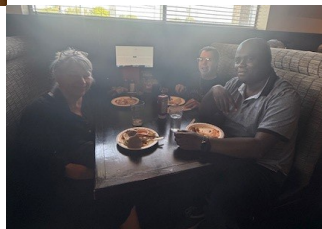


CLSC End Of Summer Party At Shoeless Joe's

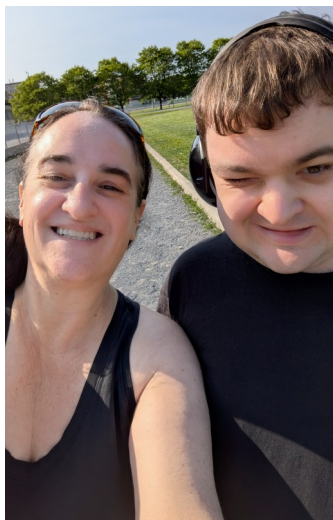

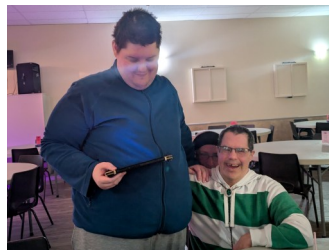


Karaoke Night

Shelly Villeneuve and her mom were also there.

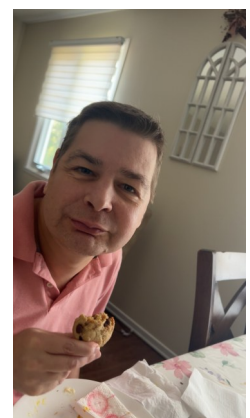

Justin and Carrol are the karaoke hosts.

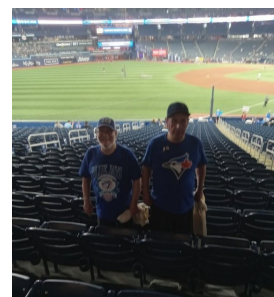

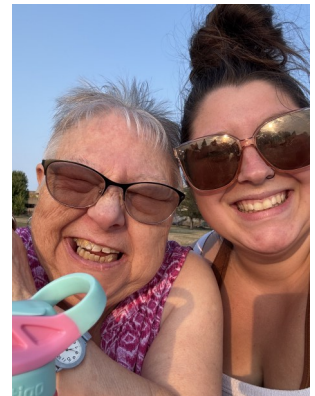


Brodeur At Arts In The Park
